

Accommodations

The first floor has a kitchenette, dining space, meeting space and a 3 stall bathroom. This floor is handicap accessible. The backdoor opens up to the outdoor patio with a grill and picnic tables.

The second floor has two bunkrooms capable of sleeping 20 people. The large bunkroom has 8 twin size bunkbeds and there are curtains for dividing the room, if desired. The smaller bunkroom has 2 bunkbeds; both have a full size bottom bunk and twin top bunks.



A Little History

The building was built in the late 1800's & used as a boarding house. St. Paul's Episcopal Church acquired the building in the mid 1900's & it became St. Paul's Episcopal School in the 1960's. It transitioned to a preschool in the 1980's called Little Friends & remained in operation until 2020 when Hurricane Zeta hit Selma and caused extensive damage.

The space was reimaged as a building to house outreach programs and was renovated to fit those needs. The renovation was completed in the Fall of 2022, just in time for the upstairs lodging to fulfill a great need for Selma. After the tornado devastated much of Selma in January of 2023, the relief workers were able to use Common Ground as they helped to clean up and rebuild our beloved city.

Cost

The cost is \$20 per person, per night, with a \$200 per night minimum. A non-refundable deposit of \$200 is required to secure the reservation and is included in your reservation total, not extra. Reservations must be canceled at least 2 weeks before the scheduled arrival time to receive a refund (less \$200 non-refundable deposit).
